PERIODICALLY, THE FILTER BAG REQUIRES CLEANING. CAREFULLY PULL THE FILTER OUT. RINSE CLEAN UNDER RUNNING WATER AND REPLACE.



BLOCKED PULSATOR

HOLD THE PULSATOR AND LOOSEN THE PHILIPS SCREW LIFT OFF THE PULSATOR AND REMOVE THE BLOCKAGE. REPLACE THE PULSATOR, TIGHTEN THE SCREW AND REPLACE THE LID





Cleaning the drain filter

Regularly clean the drain filter located at the rear of the machine.



Place a shallow container under the drain-filter to collect any residual water spillage.




Turn the filter cap in an anticlockwise direction.

Re-fit the filter along the guides ensuring that the groove in the filter aligns with the guide rib.





Warranty


